On the basis of the tenders submitted in accordance with procedure LAB P 509 "Allocating Analyses to External Laboratories in Relation with the Control Programme (see website www.afsca.be > Business Sectors > Laboratories > Control Programme, Control Plan, Analyse Plan, the Laboratories Administration has allocated the analyses of the samples that will be taken in 2009 in relation with the Analysis plan.

The pdf-document annexed to this note mention the analyses allocated to your laboratory.

If the analysis of samples originating from one of the dispatching centres (NORTH and SOUTH) has been assigned to your laboratory, please note that in normal conditions 20 to 40 % of the samples are supplied through the dispatching centre in Gembloux (SOUTH) as against 60 to 80 % through the dispatching centre in Melle (NORTH)

Some lines are marked with an asterisk. This means that the allocation of analyses may change during the year according to the requirements of the Agency in terms of analyses.

I also wish to point out that the analysis plan will be further completed in 2009, especially as far as the analyses on pesticides in food of animal origin are concerned. We will therefore send you a new Excel file later on. That file should be completed in accordance with the above mentioned procedure LAB P 509.
