IV. Declaration

The undersigned, Veterinary Officer of the General Directorate of Control of the Federal Agency for the Safety of the Food Chain (FASFC), Belgium, certifies that the products described under point I:

1. are produced in a plant which is approved by the FASFC for local market as well as for export to Israel and which is subject to official control by the FASFC;
2. do not contain ingredients derived from mammalian proteins (excluding gelatin, milk and milkproducts);
3. have been manufactured, packed and stored complying with approved manufacturing practice. Packaging material satisfies the necessary hygienic requirements.
4. The product was analyzed by a random sampling of at least five samples from each processed batch taken during or after storage at the processing plant and complies with the following standards:

Salmonella: absence in 25 g: $n = 5, c = 0, m = 0, M = 0$
Enterobacteriaceae: $n = 5, c = 2, m = 10, M = 300$ in 1 g.

Where:

n = number of samples to be tested;

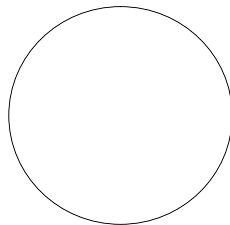
m = threshold value for the number of bacteria: the result is considered satisfactory if the number of bacteria in all samples does not exceed m ;

M = maximum value for the number of bacteria; the result is considered unsatisfactory if the number of bacteria in one or more samples is M or more: and

c = number of samples the bacterial count of which may be between m and M , the sample still being considered acceptable if the bacterial count of the other samples is m or less.

5. To the best of my knowledge and belief the consignment certified herein has not been exposed to radioactive contamination.
